An interview may be required as part of the admissions process. Out-of-state applicants may be asked to arrange a personal interview in their locales. Submission of an application for admission does not guarantee an interview nor does an interview guarantee admission.

- 4. Why do you believe you can greatly profit from the "experiential plus scholarship" model used at the Seminary?
